ART 211: Intermediate Watercolor

Credits: 3

Class Hours: 6 lecture/lab

Prerequisites: "C" or higher in ART 111.

Comments: May be repeated for a maximum of 6 credits.

Description: This course is a continuation of ART 111 that provides intensive application of basic techniques. Emphasis

is placed on the development of a personal style in the medium of watercolor.
