JPN 201: Intermediate Japanese I

Credits: 4

Class Hours: 4 lecture

Prerequisites: "C" or higher in JPN 102 or placement test score demonstrating equivalent knowledge and skills. **Description:** This is the first half of an intermediate course in spoken and written Japanese. As a second-year course, it emphasizes reading and writing. Students are expected to have an active knowledge of Hiragana, Katakana, and approximately 150 Kanji characters.

Semester Offered: Fall, Spring

Course Student Learning Outcomes (CSLOs):

- 1. Read and interpret Japanese written material effectively.
- 2. Write short sentences with accuracy using Japanese characters: Hiragana, Katakana, and a total 300 Kanji characters.
- 3. Communicate orally in Japanese within the context introduced in class.
- 4. Develop an awareness of the Japanese culture and values.
