JPN 202 : Intermediate Japanese II

Credits: 4

Class Hours: 4 lecture

Prerequisites: "C" or higher in JPN 201 or placement test score demonstrating equivalent knowledge and skills. **Comments:** The laboratory is part of the class.

Description: This is the second semester of an intermediate course in spoken and written Japanese.

Semester Offered: Fall, Spring

Course Student Learning Outcomes (CSLOs):

- 1. Write short sentences with accuracy using Japanese characters: Hiragana, Katakana, and a total 450 Kanji characters.
- 2. Read contemporary Japanese prose which uses familiar vocabulary, and demonstrate comprehension of it in Japanese.
- 3. Converse in Japanese in simple sentences with a speaker of native fluency on subjects covered in class.
- 4. Compare and contrast elements of Japanese life and culture covered in the materials presented in class with those of the home culture.
