# ART 190B : Introduction to Adobe Photoshop®

#### Class Hours: 6 lecture/lab

**Description:** This course is an introduction to Adobe Photoshop<sup>®</sup>. It is oriented to students who have not been exposed to the formal study of this software program. Students will learn the basic Adobe Photoshop<sup>®</sup> work area and tools, including such concepts as selecting, layers, filters, painting, retouching, and creating special effects. Students will work on various projects and digital images.

- 1. Use the basic interface elements of Photoshop such as tools, palettes, menus, and option bars.
- 2. Use, make, and manipulate selections, layers, layer adjustments, gradients, paths, and channels.

- 4. Open, save, and export files in appropriate formats.
